The club is arranging to send a coach to Cross Country day at Burghley Horse Trials on Saturday 4th September 2010. Departing central High Street, Hailsham at 7.30am PROMPT.

Burghley is one of only two, top level 3 day events in this country and is attended by professional riders from home and abroad. When you watch cross country day on the television the fences look fairly big but to see them up close and personal you can see how big they really are and really appreciate the skill and bravery of the horses and riders taking part. Your entry allows you to walk round the whole course (there are plenty of facilities en-route) and see amongst others the famous Maltings, Trout Hatchery, Leaf pit and Capabilities Classic. As you walk round the course there are big screens, ensuring you don't miss any of the action! If you do not fancy going round the whole course there are big screens in the main arena for you to keep track of events happening out on the course. If you still have any energy after all that, there is an extremely impressive shopping village! (or more like small town!!!).
